Indicative content of each pathway:

Time expectations of each pathway (canine or equine):

Teaching Hours: $4 \times 7 = 28$ hours

Home study hours: 4 hours a week (to include 2 weeks before commencement of the course)

13 weeks = 52 hours

Case study period: 4 hours a week for 6 weeks = 24 hours

Total hours of study per pathway: 104 hours
